L'EUROPE EN SCENES

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General rules :

The Competition Interdances has two objectives:

- Meeting students of Dance Schools in a spirit of emulation, exchange and conviviality around the same common denominator: **The pleasure of dance.**
- Fostering the emergence of new talents

This event has been in existence since 1999 and is therefore in its 22nd edition.

The previous editions welcomed more than 800 dancers, 250 groups from 6 to 30 years old and more coming from 40 municipalities.

The Jury is composed of recognized professionals of the discipline.

Everyone find a unique value in the competition, the students and their teachers, but also an enthusiastic audience of more than 1,500 people who came to support the participants.

Participation conditions:

The Interdances are open to all dancers from 7 years old regardless of their structure: conservatory, Academy, Municipal School, Private School, Association, individual etc...

The competition is open to amateurs and semi-professionals. Paid or volunteer teachers, presenting groups to the contest, can only participate in the semi-professionals category.

Holders of State Diploma can only present themselves as individual in the semi-professional category.

Categories

Groups - Duos - Solos - Trios -

In each category the groups are classified by age (+ or - 1 year):

If the group includes students of various ages, the age majority will define the category. In case of a tie, the group will be presented in the higher category.

Children – 7-10 years / Pre-Teenagers – 11-13 years /

Teenagers – 14/16 / Young Adults – 17-20 / Adults – 21 years and older

Categorie Semi-professionals: Danse Study, activity beyond 3 courses per week, aiming to be a dancer or doing many contests, dancers having received the Grand Prix or 1st Prize at previous editions of the Interdances. Semi-professionals compete in the same age or style categories as amateurs.

After registration the category and level can no longer be changed.

The organization reserves the right, depending on the number of groups engaged, to group age groups at the close of registration.

Rules of the competition:

- 1 - Can participate solos, duos, trios and groups (4 to 20 people),
- 2 - Group Categories: A teacher may present one choreography by category or a maximum of two provided that there are different students (tolerance 1 to 10).
- 3 - A teacher may have as many solos, duos or trios as he or she wishes. A dancer can only show up once in each category.
- 3 - The majority of dancers in the group must be of the age of the category in which they belong.
- 4 - Each group undertakes, if selected, to participate in the final under the same conditions as those presented at the playoffs (except cases of force majeure...), or it will be automatically disqualified. For the final, only changes or modifications in the costumes are accepted.
- 5 - Time:
Groups: **3 minutes maximum** / Solos, Duos and Trios: **2 minutes maximum**
Time Exceedance Penalty: minus 10 points

6 - Sound supports:

The musical accompaniment is the responsibility of the group. The soundtracks must be provided no later than 1 month before the competition in MP3 format. They can be sent by email or USB key specifying which group the record corresponds to. No music changes will be accepted after this date. A backup key is required on competition day.

Styles :

The dance styles that can be presented:

Classic/ Neo- Classic

Modern Jazz/ Modern

Contemporary

Urban Dances: hip hop, ragga dance hall, Break dance etc.

Other Styles: Folk, oriental dance, flamenco, cabaret, tap dancing etc.

The Jury's selection criteria are:

Technical and Interpretation - Choreographic Composition

Music/Movement Relationship - The score of the jury representing the style is coefficient 2.

Dates :

The playoffs will take place on Thursday May 26 and Saturday May 28 from 9:30 am. All training performances undertaken by a club are called on the same day. The final with awards will take place on Sunday, May 29, 2022:

Morning from 9.30 am for Children and Young Teenagers - awards around 12.30 pm.

In the afternoon from 2pm for the categories Teens, Young Adults and Adults - award ceremony in the late afternoon.

Place:

Playoffs and Finale: MUY MULTIPURPOSE HALL (83) - Avenue Saint Anne

A video broadcast room of the competition is reserved for dancers.

Registration fees:

- Subscription fees 15 euros per club mandatory
- Entitlement of 38 Euros for each performance committed: whether a group, a trio, a duo or a solo. No refund in case of cancellation.

Endowment:

Each dancer participating in the contest will receive the Medal of Interdances.

Prizes are given in each category and the jury can decide on an individual allocation for dancers, teachers or groups.

A public award will be awarded in the morning and another in the afternoon. The first will be selected in the categories Children and Young Teens, the second in the categories Teenagers, Young Adults and Adults. The entrance ticket serves as a ballot paper.

The GRAND PRIZE will be awarded to the group having won the highest number of points in the competition. The GRAND PRIX will be automatically selected to perform at the Grand Opening Concert of the International Choral Competition in Provence on Thursday July 7, 2022 in Bandol in front of more than 2,000 spectators.

The Jury may select other formations to perform on this evening if they wish.

Technical side:

All the performances are made by full-up lighting. The placement of the dancers will be done on sight. The stage has a black background curtain and a cloth on the garden side (facing the scene on the left). There is only one entrance/exit staircase on the garden side.

Dimension of the stage: 11 m of opening x 6 m of depth.

Note: The room used as a dressing room for dancers does not have mirrors.

A photographer will be present throughout the playoffs and the finale.

The photos will be published on our website and Facebook page.

Those who oppose or do not want to be photographed during the competition must let us know before the contest begins.

Registration process:

To be validated, the registration form must be accompanied with :

- For each group the students names/surname, dates of birth with copies of each student national identity card or passport
- The certificate signed by the dance school director : confirming the possession of medical certificates and insurances
- Settlement of the invoice via bank transfer
- Sound tracks in MP3 format (not later than one month before the competition)

Please return the dossier before April 29, 2022

Conscripts will be sent by email to each club 1 month before the competition indicating the day of passage for the playoffs and the hours of passage of the marking takes.

Registration deadline : April 29, 2022

Instructions :

Sceneries: All decorations and accessories must comply with current safety standards. Unretarded sets will not be accepted on stage. Avoid the profusion of accessories or decorations that clog or dirt the scene, this complicates the organization and slows down the passage of groups.

Backstage: Access to dressing rooms is prohibited for parents or chaperones who do not have a direct role in the supervision of dancers. Access to the backstage and the broadcast room is strictly reserved for dancers and their teachers.

Chewing gum, piercing and jewelry are not allowed on stage.

Penalty for non-compliance: 10 points

We particularly bring the fact to the club leaders to take special care of all the dancers and respect for the hall and people.

The organisation reserves the right to disqualify a group or school in case of disrespect towards the organizers.

The competition is open to the public.

Due to the limited number of seats in the room, we advise spectators to book in advance. Only seats will be reserved.
